Applying for the Programme:

Trampoline Impact Accelerator Programme (The “Programme”) is open to entrepreneurs ready and eager to scale their impact project. Trampoline Impact Accelerator Programme is Trampoline’s acceleration support program, and it is run in collaboration with the Currimjee group (The “collaborators”). Trampoline is a not-for-profit organisation with the mission to:

- To promote social entrepreneurship as a powerful mean to address some of the most crucial social problems of our country
- To nurture, support and enable the scaling-up of social enterprises to boost our local economy while having a positive social impact on our society
- To empower social-impact entrepreneurs in their so-doing by providing them with coaching, mentoring, training and connecting them to a network of partners

Entrants into the Programme shall be deemed to have accepted the following Terms and Conditions:

- Only one entry per enterprise.
- Only enterprises and projects impacting the Republic of Mauritius, including Rodrigues, will be considered.
- Trampoline accepts no responsibility for lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete entries or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason.
- The Application starts at 3.00 PM on 20/09/2021 and closes at 11:59 PM on 14/11/2021 (GMT+4). Entries received outside this period will not be considered. However, Trampoline reserves the right in its absolute discretion to extend the closing date where the entries received are of insufficient quality.
- You own the copyright to your application entry as its author.
- You confirm that your application entry does not contain any unregistered or undisclosed intellectual property (IP).
- By submitting an entry to the Trampoline Impact Accelerator Programme, you permit Trampoline to use your project/enterprise’s name if you are selected or as a finalist of the programme on any social media accounts controlled by Trampoline and its collaborators and in any press releases related to the programme.
- We may disqualify your Programme entry for the following reasons: your entry does not comply with the minimum Programme requirements or cannot be contacted.
- Applicants to the programme must be willing and able to commit to Trampoline’s nine months acceleration support program, starting from January 2022 and ending in September 2022, should it be proposed to them upon completion of the selection process.

Selecting the participants:

Your application will be reviewed by Trampoline’s team and the Programme’s selection committee. If you are shortlisted, you may be requested to participate in a face-to-face interview in November and/or a Demo Night in December in which participants will have to deliver a short presentation with details on their venture to a jury panel.

Trampoline reserves the right to select as many applicants as it deems fit for the programme and at its sole discretion. The Programme offer is non-exchangeable and non-transferable.

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Urgency of the problem being address, alignment to SDG goals & current local context
- Understanding of the problem and capacity to articulate the venture
- The venture's readiness to scale
- Potential social impact and ambition
- The team members expertise, experience, size and commitment
- Prototype required
- Incorporation not required
- Capacity to take value out the program & our capacity to support them
- Apolitical & legally feasible

Other rules:

- The selected enterprises may be required to participate in the promotional activity related to the programme, and shall participate in such activity on Trampoline's reasonable request.
- Trampoline accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury, or disappointment incurred or suffered by you due to entering the programme or accepting the acceleration support programme offer.
